

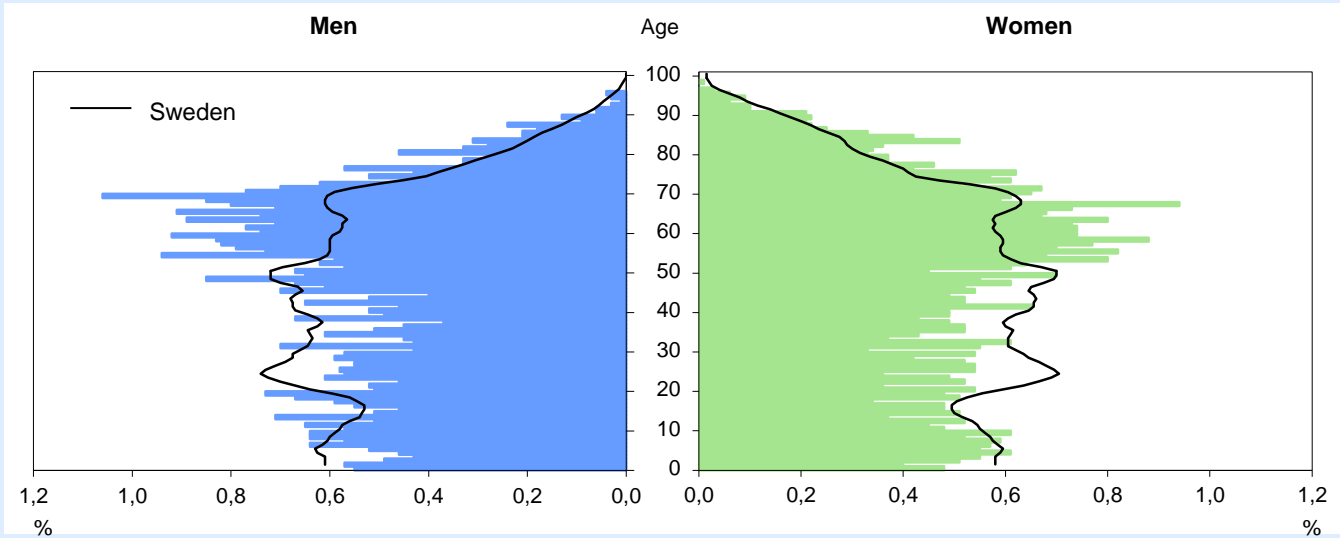

Population by age, 2014



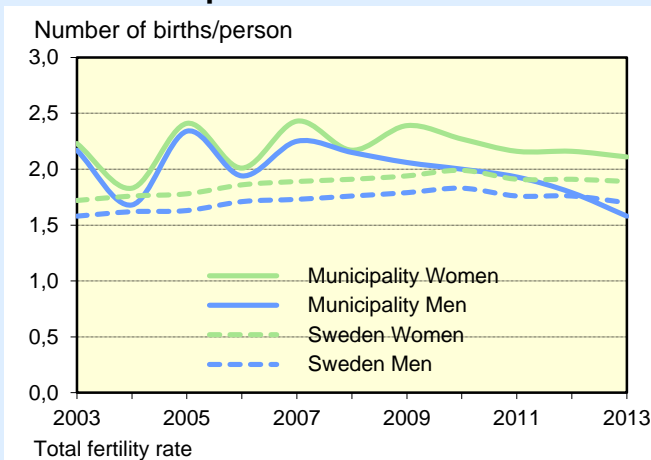

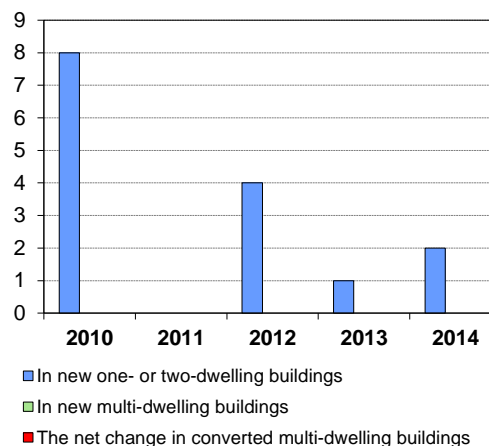

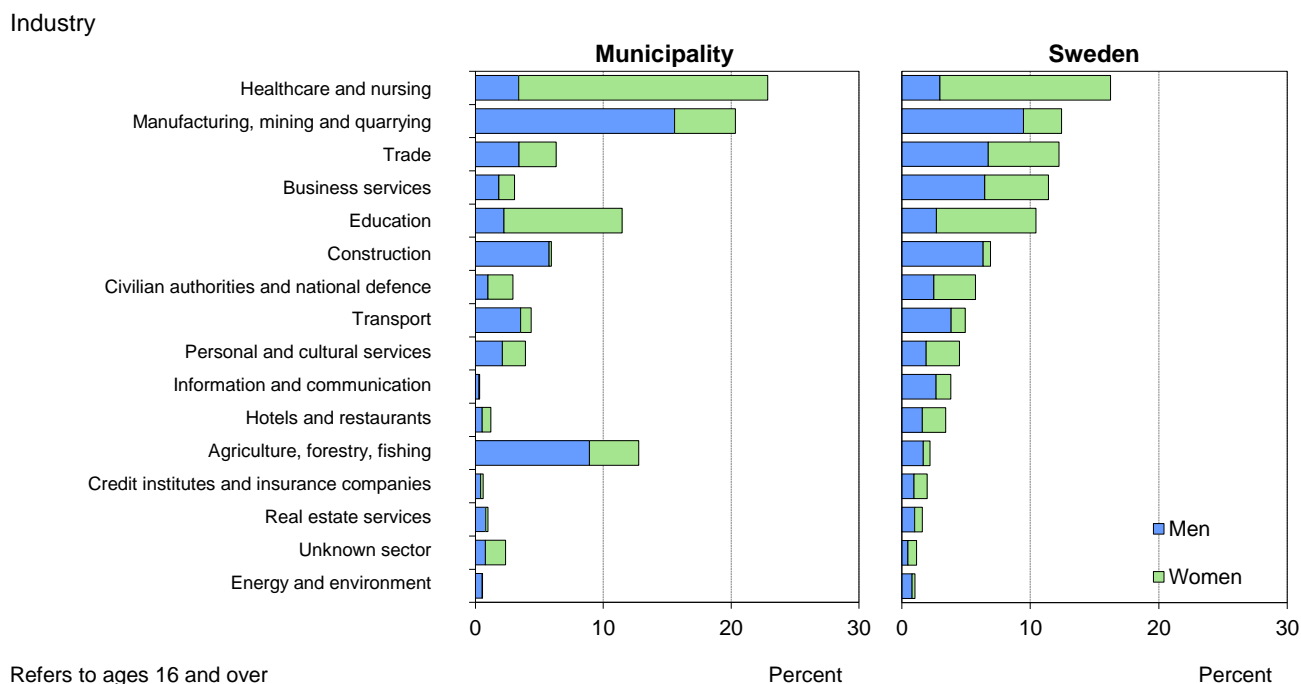

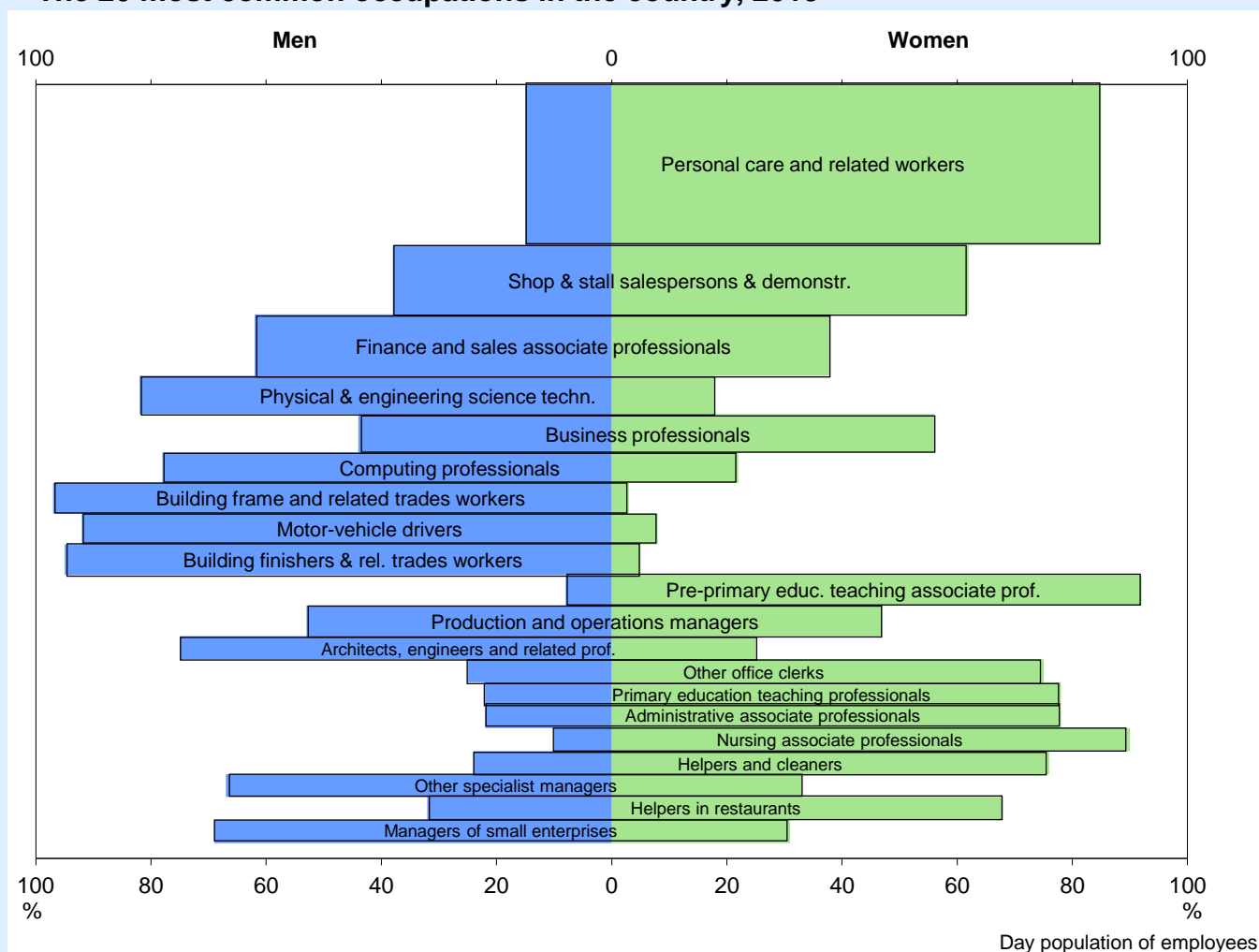

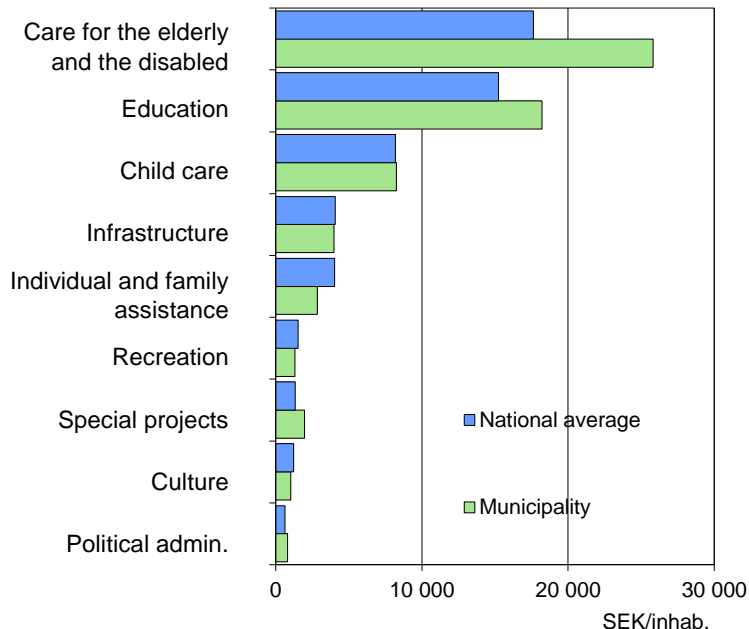
